Die onderstaande inligting moet op die aangehegde vorm ingevul word, daarsonder kan geen ontledings gedoen en aanbevelings gemaak word nie:

- Naam, posadres en telefoonnommer van produsent, asook die persoon wat die monster indien.
- Kontakbesonderhede van persoon aan wie die rekening gestuur moet word, insluitend e-pos adres.
- Kultivar, onderstok, ouderdom van wingerd/plantdatum.
- Beskrywing van simptome, verspreiding van simptome in die blok/op die plaas.

MONSTERNEMING VIR KNOPMYT EN OOGVRUGBAARHEID ONTLEDINGS

- Neem monsters na blaarval, maar voor of tydens snoei van wingerd.
- Knopmytontledings:
 - Monster 12 lote per hektaar
 - Elke loot moet die onderste 6 ogies (naaste aan die kordon) bevat.
- Oogvrugbaarheid ontledings:
 - Monster 10 lote per hektaar met 16 oë elk
- Hou monster koel en maak seker dat dit nie in die son lê of uitdroog nie. Monsters kan in 'n koelkas of koelkamer gehou word, maar moenie vries nie. Dit moet ook nie in 'n plastieksak lê en sweet nie.
- Maak seker dat elke monster duidelik gemerk is.

Besorg monsters so gou moontlik by die laboratorium in Upington (Eenheid 5, Groenpuntweg 9, Keidebees, Upington) of Klappmuts (Groenfontein Plaas, h/v R44 & Anyswortelrugpad, Klappmuts) vir ontleding.

INFORMATION REQUIRED WHEN SUBMITTING A SAMPLE FOR ANALYSIS

The following information should be completed on the form. Without the required information, no recommendations will be made.

- Name, postal address and telephone number of client as well as the person submitting the sample.
- Contact information of the person to which the invoice will be sent, including e-mail address.
- Cultivar, rootstock and plant age or date of the grapevine.
- Description and distribution of symptoms within the block on the farm.

SAMPLING FOR BUD MITE AND BUD FRUITFULNESS ANALYSIS

- Take samples after leaf fall, but before or during pruning.
- Bud mite analysis:
 - Sample 12 shoots per hectare
 - Each shoot should contain the bottom 6 buds (closest to the cordon)
- Bud fruitfulness analysis:
 - Sample 10 shoots per hectare, each with 16 buds
- Keep the samples cool and keep them out of direct sunlight. They should not dry out. Samples can be kept in a fridge or cold room but should not freeze. It should also not sweat in a plastic bag.
- Make sure samples are marked clearly.

Submit samples as soon as possible to the laboratory in Upington (Unit 5, 9 Groenpunt Ave, Keidebees, Upington) or Klapmuts (Groenfontein Farm, c/o R44 & Anyswortelrug Rd, Klapmuts) for analysis.

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
